## 2023 Village Board of Directors Elections:

Applications to be placed on the ballot for the July 2023 election to the Board of Directors will be accepted until close of business (4:00 pm) on Wednesday, May 3, 2023. Each term is two years and there will be four open seats for the Board of Directors this time. The nomination form may be obtained at the CVPOA office. If you are interested in running for the Board, please pick up an application from the office and submit it prior to the deadline of May 3rd at 4pm.

Candidates must be a member of the Association and remain current in their assessments. Candidates must have been a member of the Association for at least one year. Only one person per unit may serve on the Board at any one time. Candidates must not have had a past criminal conviction that would prevent the Association from purchasing fidelity bond coverage or that would terminate the Association’s existing fidelity bond coverage. Nominations from the floor are not permitted.







## Why Do I Dance?

So happy to know some of you are considering partner dancing. For those of us who love it, here are some benefits for us seniors that can boost your appeal!

1. For those of us with arthritis, the movements of dance are mostly low impact and use many parts of the body. This helps us move about more easily without pain.
2. Dance can be therapeutic, reducing stress, anxiety and depression, especially since dance includes music.
3. Dance can improve posture and flexibility due to standing more erect and lifting your arms.
4. Dance improves balance, which prevents falls. The connection with a partner also helps take the fear of falling away and allows more movement.
5. Unlike freestyle dance, partner dance involves our mental process too, which keeps us sharp and improves memory.
6. Dance is aerobic even at low impact levels so it improves breathing and is good for the heart. It also supports strength and muscle tone.
7. As an exercise program, it can be more effective than other forms because it is fun and you are more likely to keep doing it.
8. Dancing is a form of social interaction and makes meeting new friends easier, encouraging social bonding.

## Rattlesnakes in Winter!

Recently, I came across an article on the “A-Z Animals” website which answered my questions in regards to why we find rattlesnakes in the Village in winter. It is natural that we become complacent about

rattlesnakes in winter because many of us, myself included, have assumed that they go into hibernation as warm blooded animals do.

The truth is that cold blooded animals, including rattlesnakes, do not hibernate. Rather, they enter into a state called “brumation”, become very sluggish, and we rarely will see them. The bodily functions of a snake in brumation are reduced as much as 70%, but a warm sunny day can and will bring them out to warm their bodies. A rattlesnake is still able to strike when in brumation! Please, always remain vigilant when out tinkering in the yard, walking your dog or hiking.
